Eye cream not enough? Here are the latest medical procedures that'll leave even the most tired of eyes rejuvenated

◆ DE-SAGGING CO² THERAPY

This is micro-injections of carbon dioxide to rejuvenate and recondition saggy skin. The tiny quantities of heated CO² gas stimulate circulation, enhance the absorption of nutrients and collagen, improve the skin's texture and tighten the area under the eye and around the eyelid.

Treatments on the eyelids cost £100 per treatment (course of six recommended); sharmijoseph.com

◆ EYE BAG REMOVAL

Bags increase with age due to the accumulation of fat around the eyes which makes everything appear loose and saggy. This treatment has two laser heads: one laser melts the fat then another penetrates deeper dark patches, stimulating collagen and elastin fibres to rejuvenate the delicate area around the eye.

Treatments start at £500 for four treatments; strawberry-laser.com

◆ EYE AND CHEEK TONING

The latest in anti-ageing for the eyes: a mouthguard that is worn over the lower teeth, to get the muscles in the mouth to alter the way the jaw rests. This tension causes the face to tone up. The passive exercise on the muscles helps to open up the eyes and raise the cheekbones.

◆ REVITALISATION

Leading cosmetic doctor Tracy Mountford uses Restylane SubQ, an injectable solution containing hyaluronic acid that sits in the secondary layer of the skin. It gives your cheeks that youthful apple-like shape again.
